In addition to the information provided here, the argument shall contain the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the person(s) submitting it, or, if submitted on behalf of a bona fide association of citizens/organization, the name of the association/organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument.



City of Half Moon Bay: Advisory Measures A

Advisory Vote Only: Should the City draft and adopt an ordinance to allow and regulate commercial, greenhouse cultivation of mature cannabis plants on existing greenhouse sites in the City's A-1 (Agricultural/Exclusive Floriculture) Zoning District?

Rebuttal Argument for the Primary Argument Against:

This is an ADVISORY MEASURE ONLY to give the City Council guidance as to the community's opinions on mature cannabis cultivation for potential future ordinances.

Support our local farmers by voting in favor and cutting through the factual inaccuracies! Let farmers decide what crops to grow, and what works for their nurseries and facilities.

Here are the most important factual inaccuracies to note:

- Cannabis cultivation in existing greenhouses will have no material impact on neighboring residences due to strict State standards regarding lights, odors, security, environmental impact, and more.
- Security measures must include limitations on signage and visibility, 24-hour video surveillance and alarm systems, strict facility access controls, inventory tracking, management protocols, and more.

The City of Half Moon Bay is not a cannabis tourism destination like Humboldt County, Mendocino County, or Santa Cruz - and we do not want to turn it into one! We only support a local cannabis industry in order to help our local medical patients access safe, regulated cannabis products and local farmers access economic opportunities to keep our jobs, taxes, and decision-making local.
