# San Mateo County Remains Under Regional Stay at Home Order

- \* The greater Bay Area (ICU Capacity: 7.4%) including San Mateo County remains under the state's Regional Stay At Home Order, requiring most residents to stay home except for essential needs with limited exceptions.
- \* San Mateo County also remains in purple Tier 1 of the state's color-coded, four-tier system for easing restrictions on businesses and activities. The coronavirus is considered “widespread” in purple Tier 1, the most restrictive of the four tiers.

# San Mateo County Case Count

- \* San Mateo County Health has updated the number of positive cases to 32,596 as of January 19, 2021.
- \* Total Half Moon Bay Cases: 605 (as of 1/15)
- \* Total Coastside Cases: 1,748 (as of 1/15)
- \* Positivity Rate: 9.7%
- \* Currently Hospitalized COVID patients in San Mateo County: 181 (3 ICU beds available)

    - \* Transportation, logistics, manufacturing, Industrial, commercial, residential and shelter services
    - \* Congregate settings (incarcerated, homeless)

# Coastside Inn Shelter

- \* Current Pilot
  - \* Samaritan House oversight
  - \* Adults only
  - \* Referred through Coordinated Entry System
  - \* 9 individuals (all previously unsheltered on the Coast)
  - \* Room for up to 15
- \* County has received a single complaint that was resolved through Samaritan house

- \* Long-term planning
  - \* City/County MOU in negotiations
  - \* Operator RFP/RFO being prepared
  - \* March or April start
- \* Community Advisory Taskforce
  - \* Gov reps; service providers; community members
  - \* City/County/Operator staffed
  - \* Year+ convening
  - \* Application process

# Ballot Results

- \* City mailed over 400 ballots to affected residents
- \* Received 145 responses by due date:
  - \* 60 yes
  - \* **85 no**
- \* Next Steps based upon ballot results:
  - \* Contractor will remove striping that was completed
  - \* Contractor will continue refresh of existing red curbs
